Authorized generic for Adderall XR® capsules launched

Teva Pharmaceutical Industries announced today (Thursday, April 2, 2009) it has commenced commercial shipment of its authorized generic version of Shire Pharmaceuticals' Adderall XR® (mixed salts of a single-entity amphetamine product) capsules – 5, 10, 15, 20, 25 and 30 mg.

Shipment of this product commenced on April 2, 2009 and will be available at Medco By Mail on Friday, April 3, 2009. The generic should be available at retail Friday, April 3, 2009.
